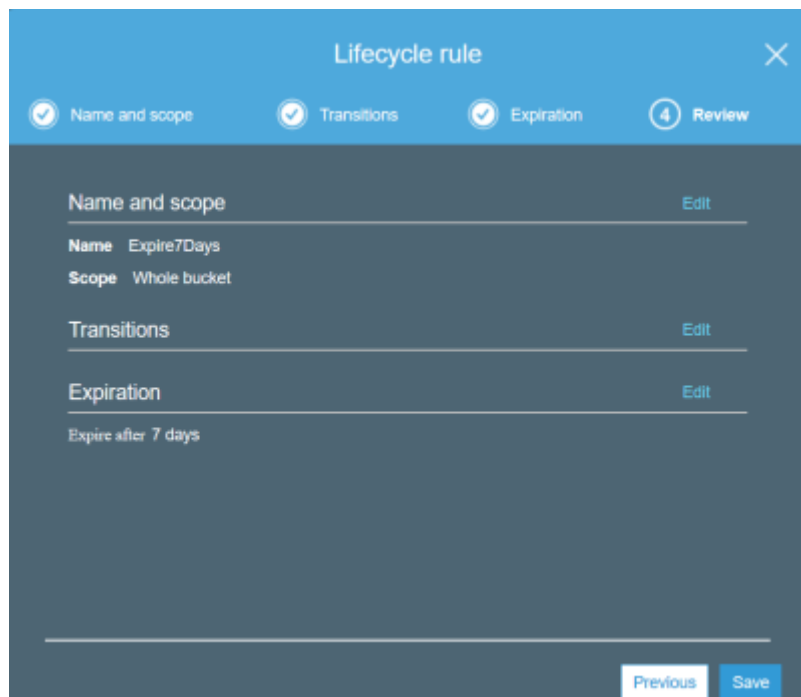


context

stappenplan

1. meld aan op AWS console, S3
2. kies de **bucket** waarvoor je expiration wilt opzetten
3. **management > Lifecycle: Add lifecycle rule**
4. geef een betekenisvolle **naam**, **Next**, **Next**,
5. **Configure expiration: Current version**
6. Expire after: geef **waarde** in
