dit document beschrijft hoe je Drupal bijwerkt naar een nieuwere versie

voorbereiding

- maak een [backup van je drupal databank](#)
- maak een backup van je bestaande drupal bestanden:

```
tar -cvzf /tmp/drupal.tar.gz <drupalDir>
```

- zet je [site in maintenance mode](#)
- meld aan op de Linux server
- verwijder:
 - /core en /vendor `rm -rf core vendor`
 - bestanden in de top-level directory `rm -f *.* .[a-z]*`
- download de laatste release: `wget`
<https://ftp.drupal.org/files/projects/drupal-x.y.z.tar.gz>
- pak de tarbal uit: `tar -xvzf drupal-x.y.z.tar.gz`
- zet de bestanden uit de nieuwe release terug:
 - `cp -Rv drupal-x.y.z/core .`
 - `cp -Rv drupal-x.y.z/vendor .`
 - `cp drupal-x.y.z/*.*`
 - `cp drupal-x.y.z/.[a-z]* .`

Use this utility to update your database whenever a new release of Drupal or a module is installed.

For more detailed information, see the [upgrading handbook](#). If you are unsure what these terms mean you should probably contact your hosting provider.

1. **Back up your code.** Hint: when backing up module code, do not leave that backup in the 'modules' or 'sites/*/modules' directories as this may confuse Drupal's auto-discovery mechanism.
2. Put your site into [maintenance mode](#).
3. **Back up your database.** This process will change your database values and in case of emergency you may need to revert to a backup.
4. Install your new files in the appropriate location, as described in the handbook.

When you have performed the steps above, you may proceed.
